

SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES for GRADUATING STUDENTS of the Faculty of Geoengineering, Mining and Geology of WUST in the summer semester of the academic year 2025/2026

In accordance with the Regulations of Higher Education Studies at Wrocław University of Science and Technology, the schedule of activities for students of the final semester (and students on leave after the final semester) has been established:

- **June 25, 2026** - completion of organized didactic classes and credit for courses of the 8th semester of part-time first-cycle studies, 3rd and 4th semester of second-cycle Master's studies, and repeat courses, with the exception of the "diploma thesis" course. In accordance with the Regulations of Studies §35 section 19: "The credit for the last subject 'diploma thesis' provided for in the study programme is granted by the person conducting this subject (thesis supervisor) after reviewing the evaluation of the reviewer. The supervisor, after reviewing the reviewer's evaluation of the diploma thesis (section 15), enters their grade for the subject into the IT system, provided that both evaluations are positive, even if they are different. In the event that one of the evaluations of the diploma thesis (either from the supervisor or the reviewer) is unsatisfactory, the entry into the IT system is suspended. The supervisor enters the grade immediately after the final evaluation of the diploma thesis is determined by the dean, in the procedure described in section 17."
- **June 26, 2026 – July 14, 2026** (3 Saturdays: June 27, 2026, July 4, 2026, and July 11, 2026) – summer examination session.
- **by June 26, 2026** – STRICT deadline for uploading completed diploma theses to the APD system. Immediately after uploading the thesis to the APD system and the acceptance of this version in the APD system by the supervisor, the graduating student is obliged to inform the reviewer of this fact via e-mail.
- **by July 3, 2026** - submission by students to the DEAN'S OFFICE of printed diploma theses along with all documents – the list of documents is available at [Diploma students / Faculty of Geoengineering, Mining and Geology](#) The theses may be submitted earlier, after obtaining all grades in the transcript and printing all documents, but no later than July 3, 2026.
- **by July 3, 2026** - final deadline for submitting applications to the Dean for an extension of the diploma thesis submission deadline; in such case, the theses must be uploaded to APD by September 2, 2026, and the complete set of documents should be submitted to the dean's office by September 8, 2026. Defenses for persons who submitted an application for extension are tentatively scheduled for September 15-18, 2026.
- **in the period: July 10, 2026 – July 17, 2026**
 - engineering diploma examinations for first-cycle students according to a detailed schedule, which will be established after verifying the number of graduating students admitted to them.
 - Master's diploma examinations for second-cycle students according to a detailed schedule, which will be established after verifying the number of graduating students admitted to them.
