

SCHEDULE OF PROCEDURES for GRADUATING STUDENTS

Faculty of Geoengineering, Mining and Geology
Winter semester of the academic year 2025/2026

Pursuant to the *Regulations of Higher Education Studies* at Wrocław University of Science and Technology, the following schedule of procedures has been established for students in their final semester (as well as for students returning from leave after the final semester):

- **15 December 2025** – completion of organized didactic activities and finalization of all courses in semester VII of first-cycle studies, as well as any repeated courses, with the exception of the *"Diploma Thesis"* course.
In accordance with §35, section 19 of the *Regulations of Studies*:

"The completion of the final course, Diploma Thesis, as specified in the study programme, shall be carried out by the course supervisor (thesis advisor) after reviewing the reviewer's assessment. The supervisor, upon reviewing the reviewer's evaluation (section 15), shall enter their own grade into the information system provided that both grades are positive, even if they differ. If either the supervisor's or the reviewer's grade is unsatisfactory, the entry into the system shall be suspended. The supervisor shall enter the final grade immediately after it has been approved by the Dean, in accordance with the procedure described in section 17."

- **16 December 2025 – 19 January 2026**
(including two Saturdays: 20 December 2025 and 10 January 2026) – winter examination session for students of semester VII.
- **by 18 January 2026 – FINAL DEADLINE** for submitting completed diploma theses to the **APD (Archive of Diploma Theses) system**.
Immediately after submitting the thesis to the APD system and obtaining the supervisor's approval of the submitted version, the student must notify the reviewer by e-mail.
- **by 23 January 2026** – submission of **printed diploma theses** along with all required **documents** to the **Dean's Office**.

Theses may be submitted earlier (after obtaining all grades and printing all required documents), but no later than **23 January 2026**.
- **by 23 January 2026 – final deadline** for submitting requests to the **Dean** for an **extension of the thesis submission deadline**, applicable only to students who have received credit for all courses, and whose thesis supervisor provides a positive opinion confirming the possibility of completing the thesis within the extended period.
The maximum extension period granted by the Dean's Office is **until 25 February 2026** (submission to APD until **20 February 2026**).
Students who apply for an extension will **not** be eligible for admission to second-cycle (Master's) studies in the summer semester.
Thesis defenses for students granted extensions are **preliminarily scheduled for 3–6 March 2026**.
- **Period: 27 January – 5 February 2026**

Engineer's Diploma Examinations (First-cycle studies) – according to a detailed schedule to be announced after verification of the number of eligible candidates.

Master's Diploma Examinations (Second-cycle studies) – according to a detailed schedule to be announced after verification of the number of eligible candidates.
